Getting Started

To achieve your goals and objectives in connection with domiciling in the U.S.A., you will need to form a Wyoming company and for non-U.S. clients, the Limited Liability Company is our preferred choice. You can be the sole owner-the single member or if you have an established company in your country, it can be the owner.

Steps To Establishing Your U.S.A. Wyoming Domicile and Nexus

Establishing your Wyoming corporation or LLC is only the first step of establishing a nexus of business activity in Wyoming.

1. Establish a Wyoming corporation or LLC, and appoint your Wyoming Registered Agent (required by law) which establishes the company's official address in Wyoming at your registered agent's address.
2. Establish your company's principal business presence with a "Virtual Office" and a Wyoming phone/fax number (307 area code) and mail services.
3. Open a Company bank account (subject to bank acceptance) and/or utilize our Escrow Account to receive company money and make company disbursements

Why Wyoming?

Wyoming's reputation for leading through innovation is one reason why the State of Wyoming has earned a well-deserved reputation as an excellent place to locate businesses and create estate plans.

Wyoming has:

- **No state tax (income, estate, capital gains, corporate or gift)**
- **No tax on mineral ownership**
- **No intangibles tax**
- **Low property tax**
- **Fast and efficient court systems, which include access to Teton County, Wyoming judiciary and juries. Teton County, Wyoming is one of the wealthiest counties in the U.S. and the judiciary has vast experience in the issues of high net worth families and individuals.**
- **Strong privacy laws, including LLC protections and no owner registration or disclosure requirements**

The Wyoming LLC

In 1977 Wyoming became the first state to authorize the limited liability company (LLC). Other states followed suit by adopting LLC acts of their own, especially after the Internal Revenue Service (IRS) granted LLCs formed pursuant to Wyoming's original LLC Act (Original LLC Act or Original Act) favorable partnership tax status in 1988.

With its adoption of the 2010 Wyoming Limited Liability Company Act, the Wyoming legislature has chosen an "opportune moment to identify the best elements of the myriad 'first generation' LLC statutes and to infuse those elements into a new, 'second-generation' uniform act." On March 5, 2010, Governor Dave Freudenthal signed into law the 2010 Wyoming Limited Liability Company Act.

Wyoming continues to be the best place to form an LLC:

- **LLCs Require Less Paperwork Than a Corporation.** There is less paperwork required to keep an LLC current. Formal requirements of board of director meetings, shareholder meetings are not required for Wyoming LLCs.
- **Wyoming Has No Business Tax.** Wyoming does not force you to register your business with the State and pay a fee simply to be a business in Wyoming. Nevada recently shocked the registered agent and incorporation community by requiring a business registration tax of \$100, after paying hundreds more to form your corporation.
- **Limitation of Liability.** The officers and directors of a Wyoming corporation are protected by statute and case law from the debts and actions of the corporation.
- **Information Privacy is the Default.** In broad terms, Wyoming does not share taxpayer information with the Internal Revenue Service (IRS).
- **Complete Anonymity is Possible.** Annual reports require the name of only one person and report only the assets located in Wyoming.

- **Low State Fees.** The Wyoming state filing fee is only \$100; the annual report fee is \$50. There are no "hidden fees" for registering Managers or changing your address, as might happen with other States such as Nevada.
- **Low Regulation is the Rule.** Wyoming does not have the bureaucratic regulations of many states.
- **Single Member LLCs Are Allowed.** One person is all you need to create and manage a Wyoming LLC. Single-member LLCs are disregarded entities by the IRS because profits and losses are passed directly onto the sole Member's federal tax return (eg., Form 1040). Though they are allowed, keep in mind that LLCs are intended to function as a partnership and some corporate protections have been successfully challenged in courts for single-member LLCs.
- **Nominee Managers Are Allowed.** For maximum privacy, you can use a nominee manager for your LLC. This prevents your name from appearing on the public record.

The Wyoming Close LLC

For international clients who utilize their non-U.S. companies to hold Wyoming LLC's, we frequently utilize the "Close LLC." The Close LLC was created by an act of the Wyoming legislature especially for small LLC's which have a small number of Members, usually having ties to one another through family relationships or friends and business partners. Close LLC's are special classes of regular business limited liability companies electing to operate in a more informal manner likened to partnerships.

Regular business LLC's must conduct member and director meetings and provide members with written proposals for any major action to be voted on in the annual meetings. The Close LLC is not required to hold annual meetings and a board of directors also is not required, so there is much less paperwork required for ongoing operations. The Wyoming Close LLC Law allows small LLC's to forego many traditional corporate formalities.

Advantages

- **Management** - LLC's can be member managed or non-member managed - and Nominee Managers are allowed.
- **Limited liability** — the law says members don't have personal liability, even though they relax corporate formalities in operations.
- **Ease of operation** — operates without pomp and circumstance required in regular LLC's where a large number of members must receive information and vote.
- **Cost of operation** — relaxed corporate governance means lower legal, accounting and administrative fees for lower total cost of operation.
- **Deadlock prevention** — provides access to the court when members are deadlocked and harm could befall the LLC through lack of action.
- **Buy-out provisions** — members may buy out a deceased member's interest according to member agreements.

Your Wyoming Registered Agent.

The State of Wyoming (as with all states in the U.S.) requires companies to have an in-State Registered Agent to receive official mail from the Wyoming Secretary of State, and any other legal process on behalf of your corporation, such as a civil summons and complaint. LIAISON GLOBAL PARTNERS Ltd has an affiliate which is registered with the Wyoming Secretary of State as a Commercial Registered Agent, is locally owned and based in Cheyenne, Wyoming, and a few blocks from the Secretary of States' office.

Official and legal mail is logged, scanned and emailed to you, and sent to you in your monthly mail dispatch via U.S. International Priority Mail service, within 3 business days of the month following the ending month.

Includes everything you need to do business remotely and virtually in the State of Wyoming:

- **Local Wyoming Phone Number.** Your own Wyoming 307 area code phone number lets you have the actual appearance of being located in Wyoming. Your phone calls are forwarded to your telephone connected through the Internet.

- **Local Wyoming Fax Number.** Faxes are received on your 307 area code fax number and sent to your email automatically by our server.
- **Wyoming Street Address.** Have the prestige of your own office based in Cheyenne, Wyoming. Your virtual office package includes a Wyoming street address with suite number to receive any U.S. Mail or UPS and FedEx packages on behalf of your company.
- **Unlimited Mail Forwarding of Letters.** We forward mail once a month by U.S. International Priority Mail to your designated mail-forwarding address.
- **Forwarding of Packages and Large Items at Cost.** Any packages we receive for your company are forwarded to you by FedEx Courier service, pre-paid and you are billed our cost.
- **VoIP Telephone Adapter.** Answer and place calls on your Wyoming number anywhere where there is an Internet connection. Simply plug your existing phone into the VoIP adapter we send you, and plug the adapter into a network jack, and you are ready to take calls from your Wyoming business line.
- **Voicemail and Voicemail-to-Email.** When you are away from your phone, or speaking with another client, callers are automatically directed to voicemail. Once the caller leaves a message, it is emailed to you in a .WAV sound file.
